



# 2019 / CURRENT RIVER FLOAT & FISHING TRIP June 6-9

Thursday - Saturday (Sunday optional)

**IMPORTANT STEPS /** 1) **Sign your Liability Waiver** @ [abundantlifels.com/men](http://abundantlifels.com/men) by May 19, indicating the nights you will camp and 2) **Reserve your Camp Site and Boat Rental** through Jadwin Canoe Rental by May 19. Reserve your boats and campsites early - if you wait, the availability of these may not be there.

## AGENDA

Thursday afternoon and evening	Setting up camps / fellowship / cooking
Friday morning - 8 am pick up*	12 mile float / Akers to Pulltite / 6 -7 hour trip
Friday afternoon and evening	Back to camp / clean up and cook / evening service
Saturday morning - 8 am pick up*	8 mile float / Cedar Grove to Akers / 4 hour trip
Saturday afternoon	Break camp / head back home
Sunday morning (optional)	Some men are staying an extra day to float & fish.

**CAMPERS /** Reserve your Camp Site and Boat Rentals by May 19 - contact Jadwin Canoe Rental and mention that you are with Abundant Life. Our fees are on page 2 of this document.

- All campers are responsible for their own food and drink, so plan well for your cooking and lunches on the float trip. You will want water tight sealed packaging for your lunch on the river.
- Wood for campfires may be bought at the Campground Office and delivered to your camp site for \$5.00 a bundle.
- There are several outdoor cooking grills for charcoal fires and every camp site can have an open fire. Guys will also share their fires or grills if you ask nicely!
- There are many electric hook up sites . . . register early though. Only as available.
- There is a shower (2 quarters) within walking distance of the campground that is available to the public along with toilets.
- Each morning, a bus will provide us transportation to the launch site and pick us up at the end of the float. Bring your alarm . . . bus comes by at 8 am to pick us up!\*

## FISHING / Must have valid license.

- Saturday's float provides some good "white ribbon trout" fishing. Any lure, spinners, artificial bait, or natural baits are permitted on this stretch of water.
- Daily limit is 4 trout, of which only 1 may be a brown trout 15 inches or longer.
- All those who would fish for trout MUST have a valid Missouri Fishing License and a Missouri Trout Permit on them.

Salem is the best town north of the Campgrounds and it has a Walmart, if you want to pick up supplies en-route.

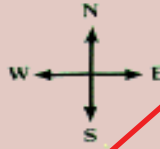

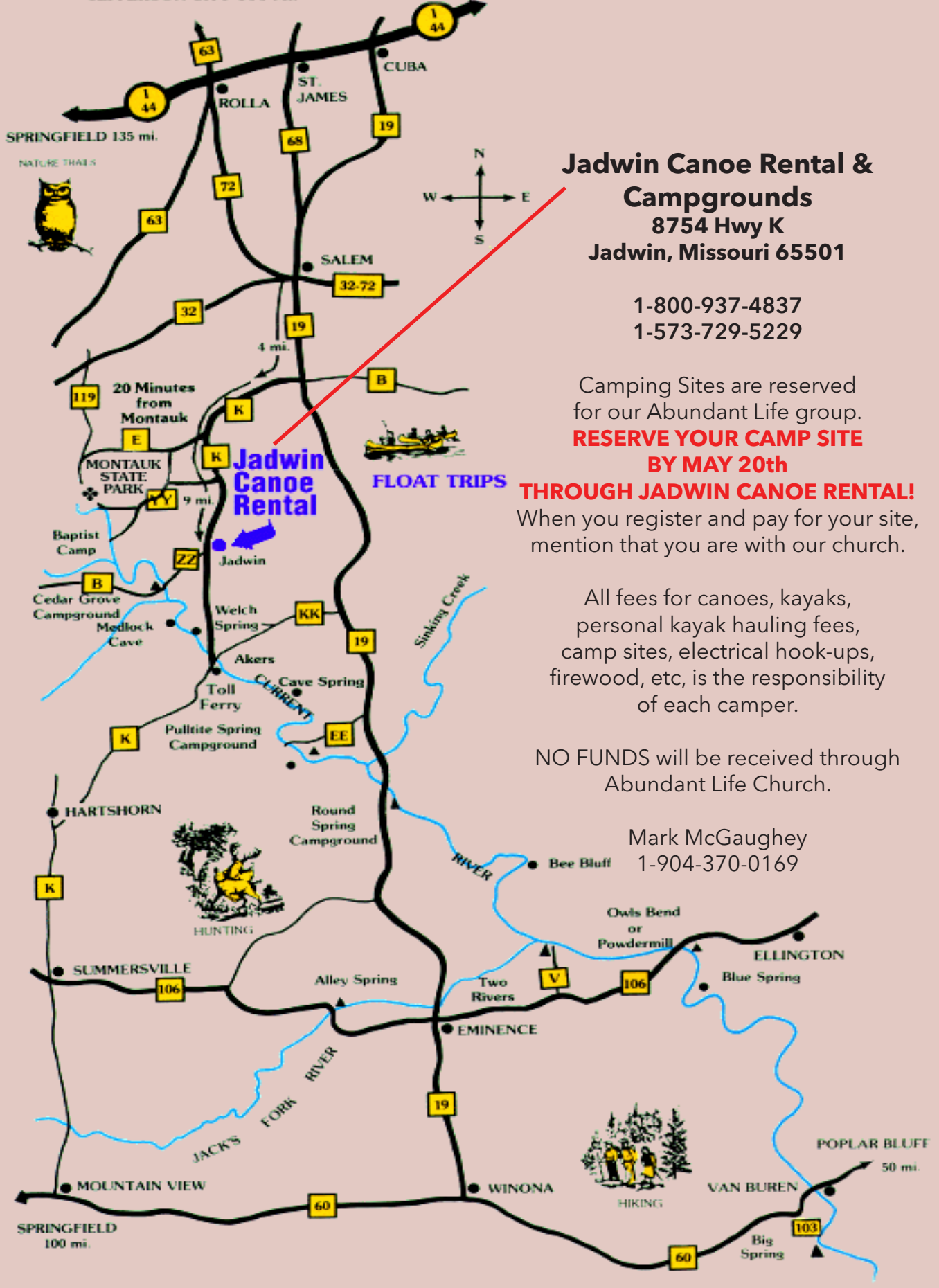

**Daniel McKim** is our special speaker this year at the Current River Float Trip. He went to the Northwest Missouri State University and became an All-American in the shot put and 15-time National Qualifier in five events.

Daniel started throwing in The World Highland Games in 2004, turning professional in 2007, after being the #1 ranked amateur that year. Since then, he has joined the ranks of only a few, having won 5 World Highland Game Championships and 6 US Champions.

Now living in Maryville, Missouri, Daniel and his wife, Natalie have a great family of boys! Daniel works with the men and married couples of Laura Street Baptist Church, where his father has pastored for 35 years.

This event offers fathers and sons a fantastic experience outdoors on one of the most beautiful rivers in the state of Missouri. Whether you are fishing for trout, or just cruising down the river, there are many things to be experienced that leave a lasting memory to be cherished for a lifetime. If you bring your sons, just consider that they must be old enough to take direction, as the river can be tricky, and old enough to handle challenges without freaking out. Some would suggest that a young boy be at least 10 years old or older. That is up to the parent.
